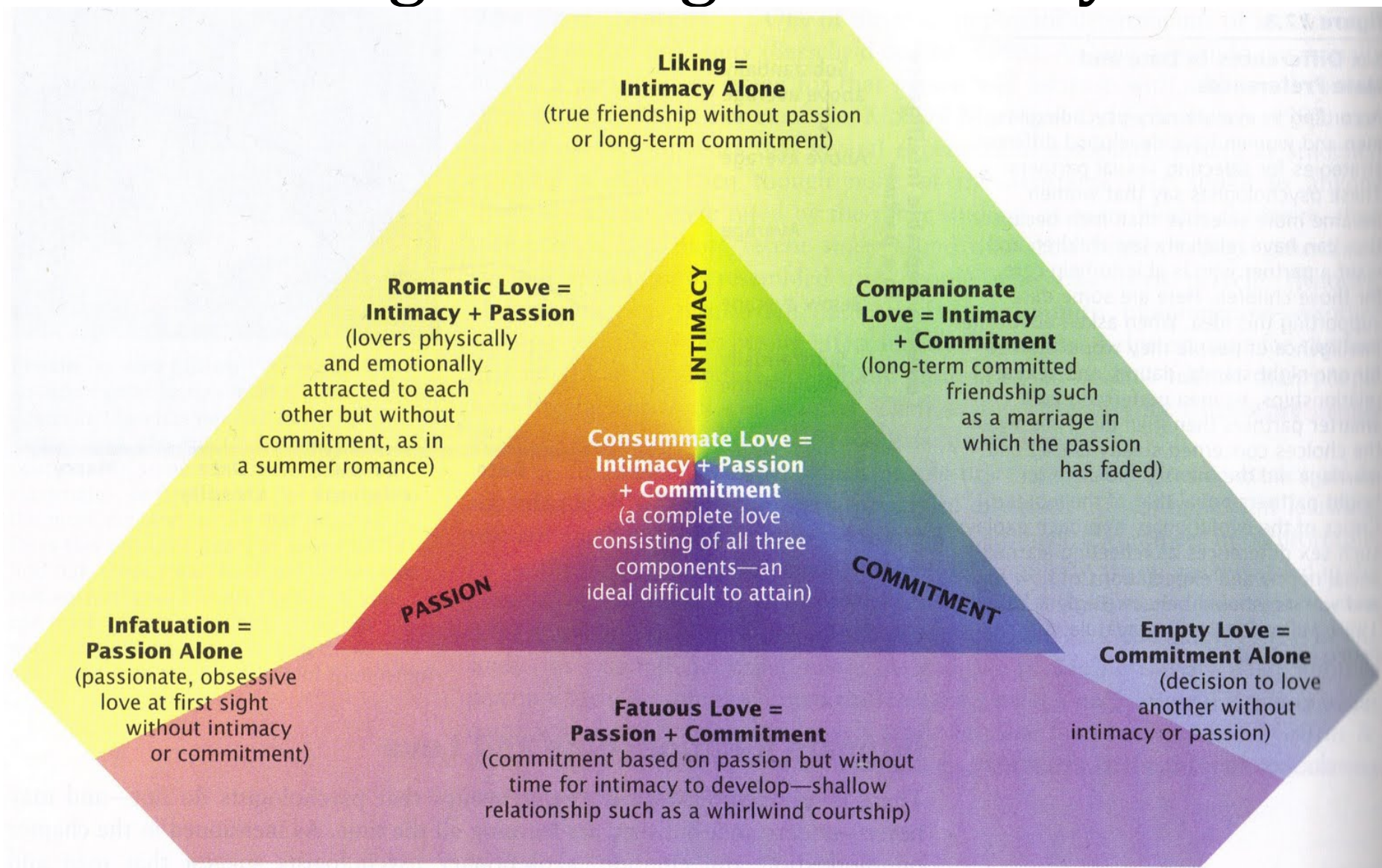


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Sternberg's Triangular Theory of Love



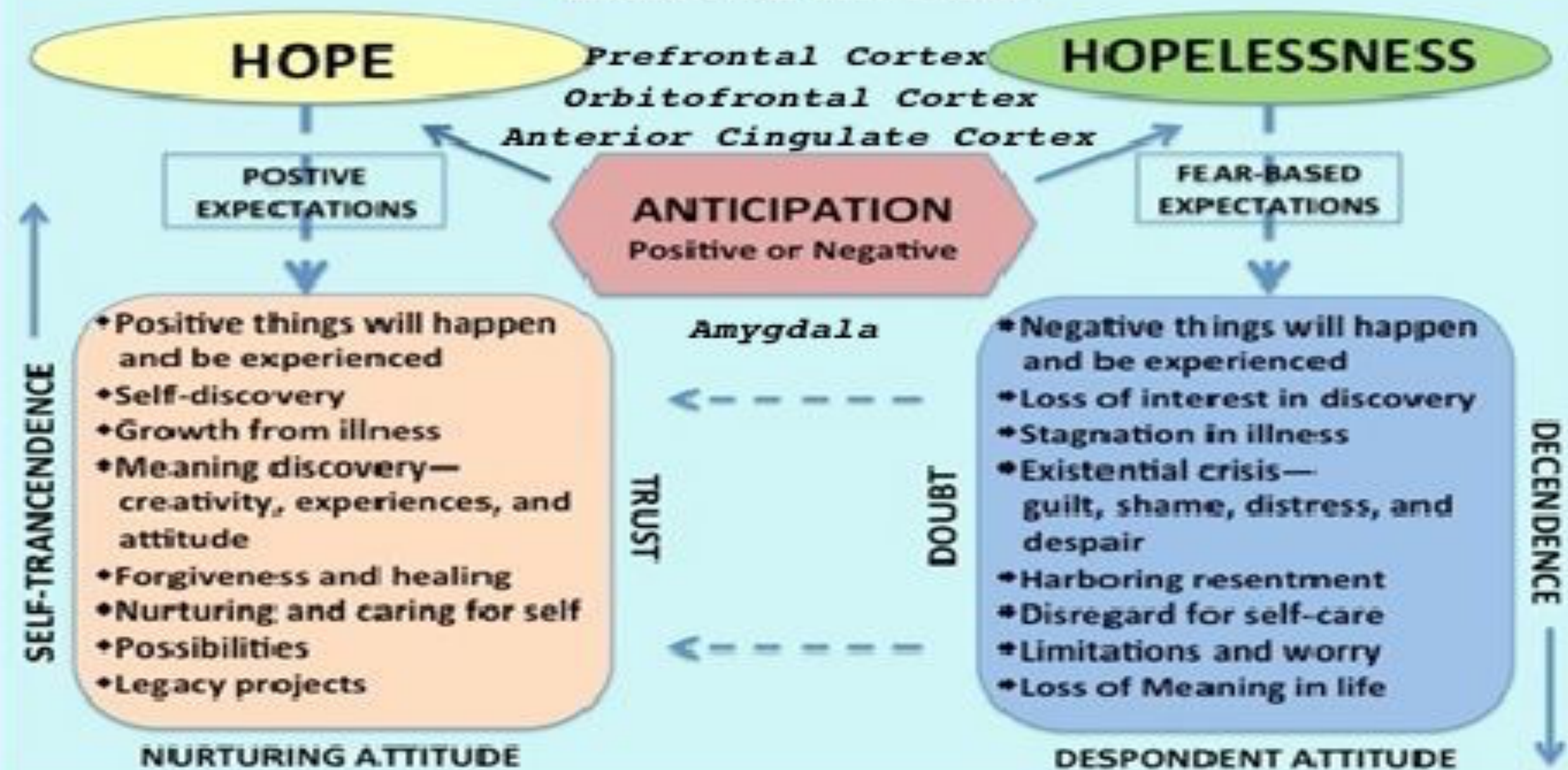
According to Sternberg, different types of love result when the three basic components in his triangular theory occur in different combinations. Sternberg has also explored factors associated with falling in love. Preliminary results suggest that people who share similar views about what a loving relationship should be like are much more likely to fall in love with each other, and remain committed to the relationship that are people whose views on love are dissimilar.

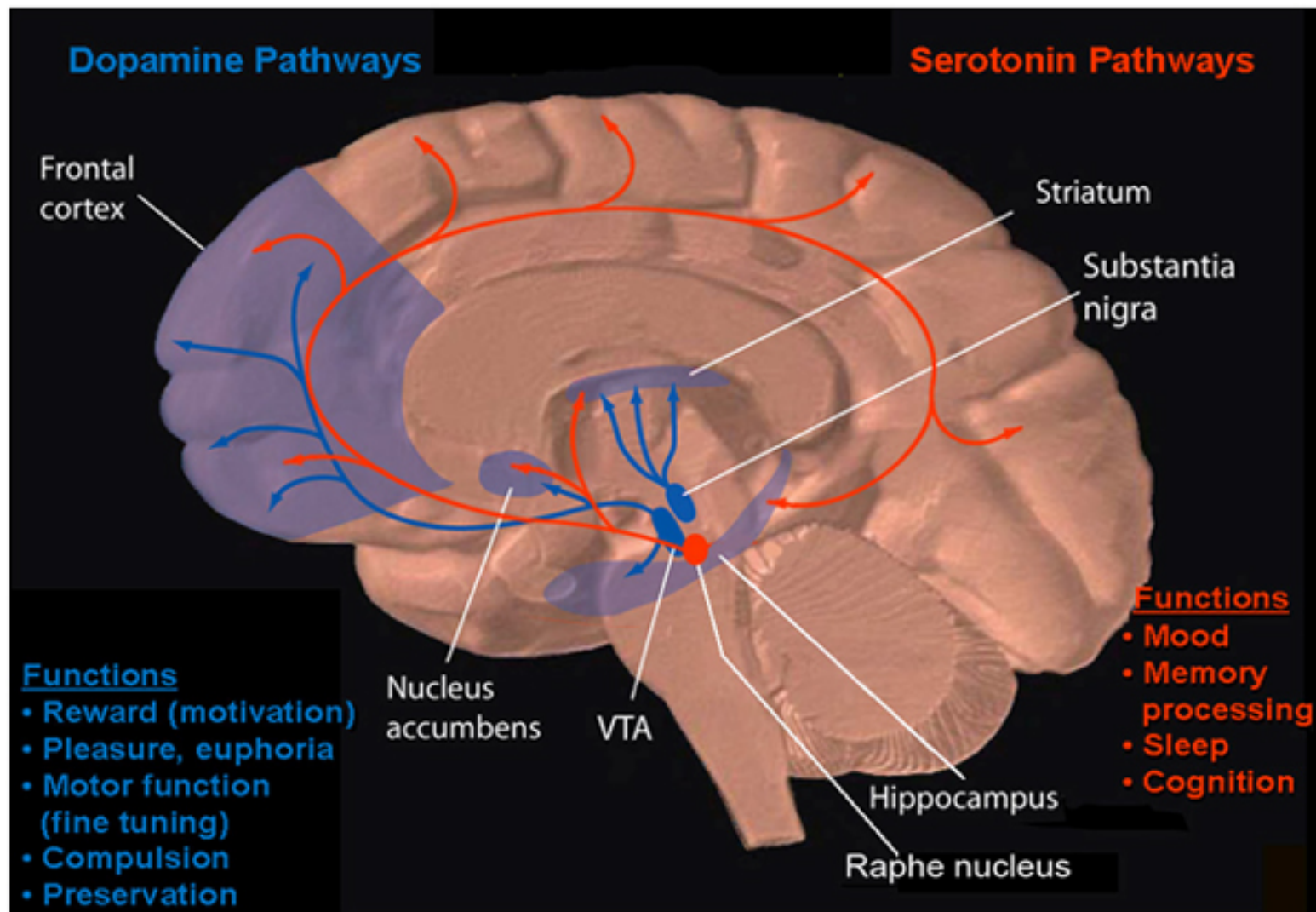

Addiction: a neurological explanation

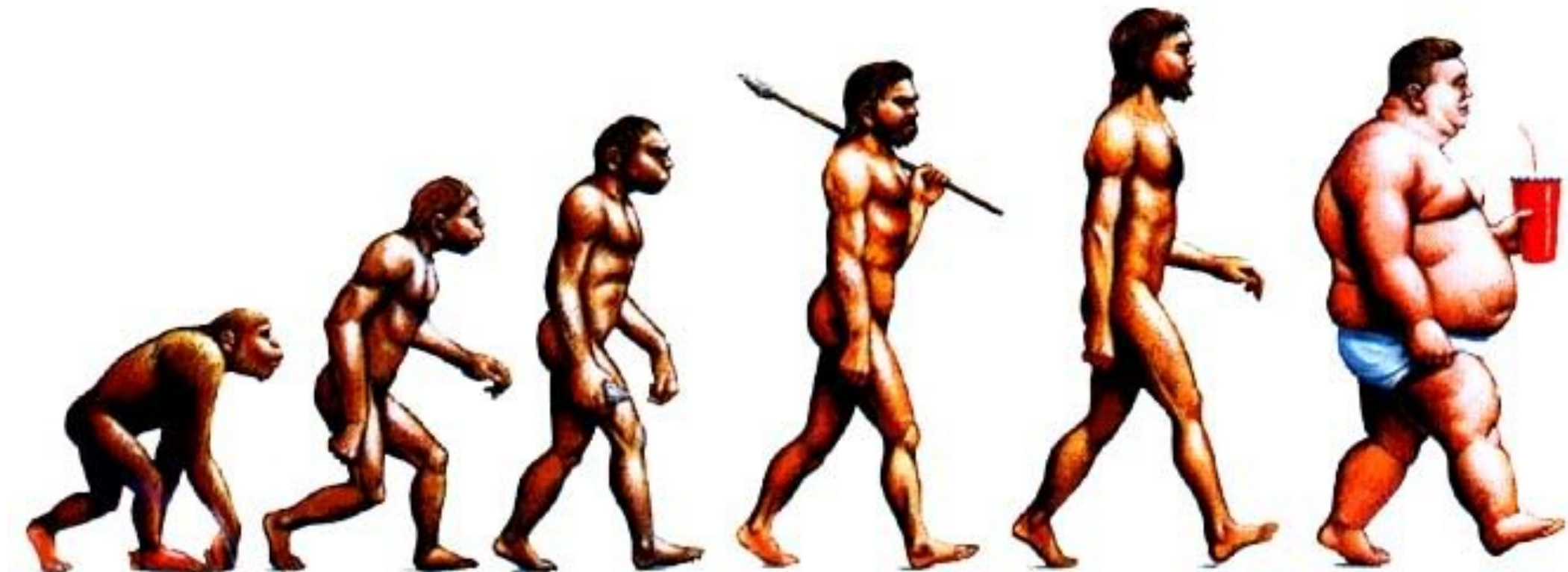


Food, sex, drugs, gaming and screens in general do all stimulate the same cerebral regions.

- Hippocampus

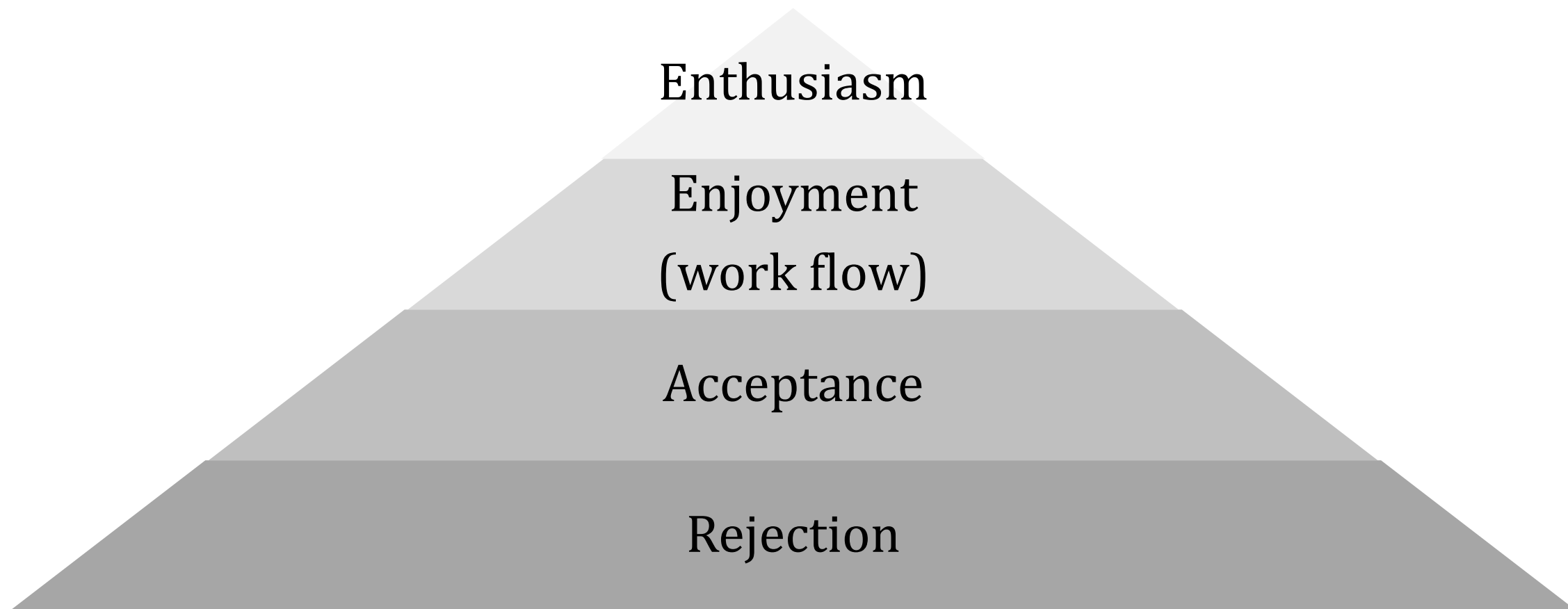
Learned Hopelessness

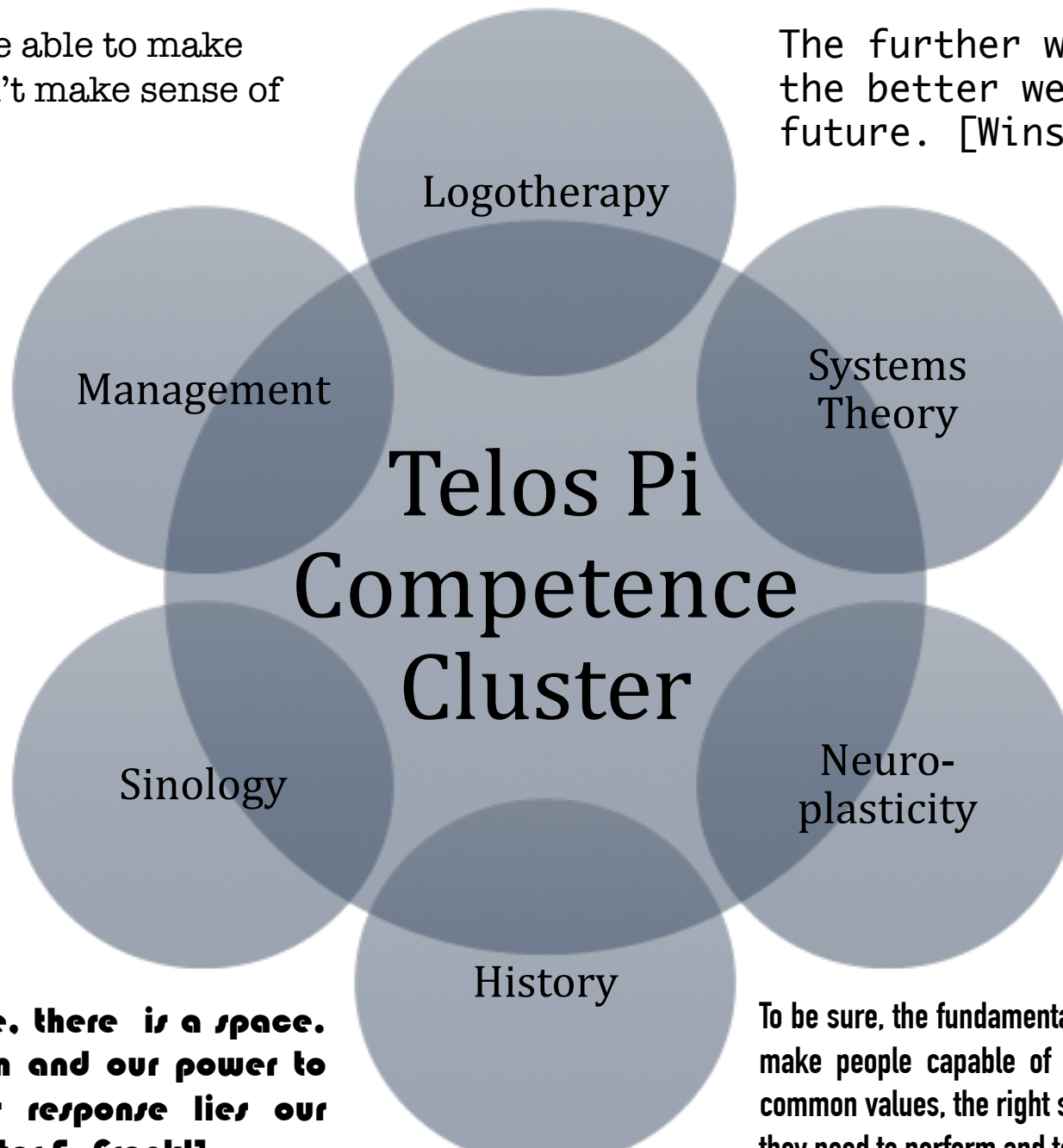


In a few years, you will not be able to make sense of the world, if you can't make sense of China. [Martin Jacques]
